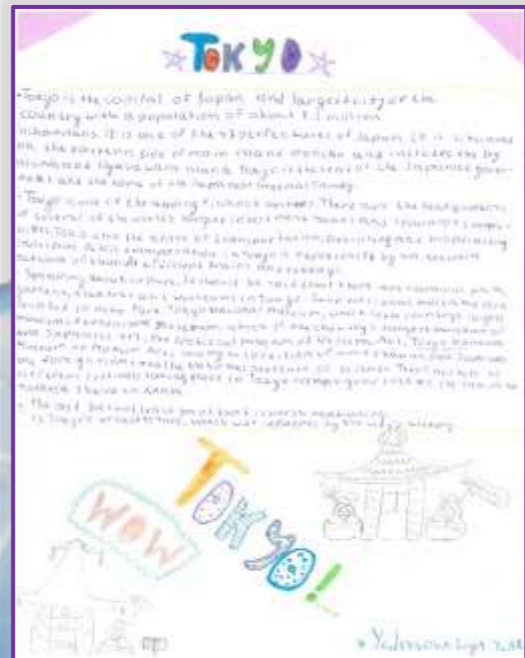
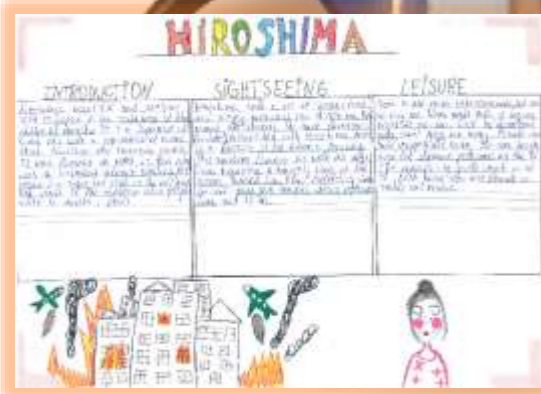
Web community connects people across the world, using different forms of communication and makes the world smaller.

Cyber space

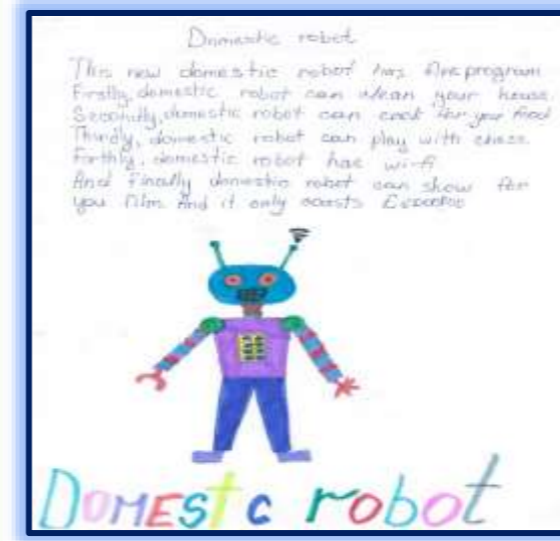
With the purpose of changing our world we develop scientific and technical innovations in a creative way to make the society function better.

What are the advantages and disadvantages of private education?

Nowadays a lot of parents have chosen to send their children to private schools, instead of state schools. However, there are some parents that think we should ban private education. Arguments surrounding this issue will be discussed.

To start with, most private schools have better facilities than state schools. Since private schools are business, they would have better facilities to "attract" students. Public schools are run by the government. They don't have the finance to have good enough facilities. Public schools only give the mandatory necessities/program, nothing more, nothing less. Private schools also have better education and reliable teachers. In public schools classes usually have 20-30 people. It is very hard for the teacher to pay attention to every individual student. Private schools have less people in each class, so teaching/learning is much easier.


On the other hand, private schools are expensive, whereas state schools are free. Not everyone can afford to pay to go to the private schools, and education is a basic human right. All private schools are based on money, all they want is profit. The more students they have, the more money they earn. To keep parents pleased, most of the time they give children the marks they don't deserve.

All in all, I believe that people need to have the freedom to educate their children in a manner they approve of. This includes homeschooling, as well as private schools. While there needs to be some certain level of oversight, as far as standardized testing, people still should have the right to educate their children as they see fit.
